

**Dana Suskind, MD** is a pediatric otolaryngologist who specializes in hearing loss and cochlear implantation. She is also the founder and director of the Thirty Million Words Initiative at the University of Chicago.

**Donna Sorkin, MA** is the Executive Director of the American Cochlear Implant Alliance (ACIA). She has previously served as the Vice President for Consumer Affairs, Cochlear Americas and Executive Director of both Alexander Graham Bell Association for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing and Hearing Loss Association of America. She works with patients, families, health professionals, educators, national and local officials to increase understanding of key hearing loss issues impacting both children and adults. As a cochlear implant recipient herself, she is able to share first-hand the benefits of implantation.
